

As stated previously, *the easiest, most convenient, and most efficient method of transporting your student to and from school will be through our bus system.* Reidland Elementary School students are transported on buses that carry only elementary students. School bus drivers are in full charge of the bus and have control of all school children transported between the homes of the children and the school. The driver shall keep order, maintain discipline among the students, and observe bus regulations at all times.

A copy of bus regulations is sent home with each child. The privilege of any pupil to ride a bus is conditioned upon his/her good behavior and observance of these rules and regulations. Students may be suspended from bus privileges as outlined in the District Student Code of Conduct.

The State requires four (4) bus evacuation drills per year. Every student will be involved even if they do not ride on a regular basis because of field trips.

Please Note: Any student in Kindergarten or First Grade must have an adult visible with a passport to the bus driver before he/she will be released from the bus. A student may be released from the bus with a sibling that is at least 9 years of age. If neither of these conditions are met, the student will be returned to school and a parent will be called.
