

Zap!

Created by Box Cars and One Eyed Jacks

1. You will need 2 six-sided dice and playing cards.

**For this game you will need to have mom or dad take out all the aces, kings and jokers. You will be using the 2's-10's and the Jacks (think of them as 11's) and the queens (think of them as 12's)

2. You will need to play this game with at least two players (this would be a fun game for the whole family!)

3. Shuffle the cards. Each player is dealt 7 cards. The rest of the cards are not needed.

4. Player One rolls the two dice and adds them together.

5. If any of the cards in Player One's hands match the total rolled on the dice, he/she can place those cards down. If there are no matches then Player One says "ZAP!"

6. Now the other players race to see if they can make a match using the cards in their own hands. Only the first one to find a match may put his or her cards down.

7. Player two rolls the two dice and follows the same procedure listed above.

The first player to empty his/her hand of cards wins!
