

- Fire, tornado, earthquake, bomb threat, shelter-in-place, and lockdown drills are held throughout the year.
- Universal Emergency Procedures include: Evacuation, Reverse Evacuation, Severe Weather Safe Area, Shelter in Place, Lockdown, and Drop, Cover, and Hold.
- The fire alarm is sounded automatically and will be a continuous sound of the fire alarm and accompanied by a strobe light. All persons are to leave the building quickly and quietly.
- A tornado drill is sounded by a continuous siren through the intercom system. Students should go to the designated areas within the school building.
- Earthquake, bomb threat, shelter-in-place, and lockdown drills are announced.
- For the safety of our students, there is no admittance to our school during Lockdown and Shelter in Place until the “all clear” determination.

Evacuation Plans and School-Centered Emergency Management and Recovery Guide are located in each classroom and throughout the school.
