

1. No running, jumping, or pushing in hallways or on sidewalks.
2. No loud talking in the hallways or bathrooms.
3. No hats worn in the building.
4. No toys, radios, jam boxes, trading cards, electronic games, etc., brought to school. Items will be confiscated and kept until end of term.
5. No fighting, scuffling, or wrestling on the school grounds.
6. No student use of phone unless it is an emergency.
7. Students must bring a note signed and dated by parent/guardian whenever there is a change in the way they come to or leave from school. If they do not ride the bus home, they must remain in the classroom until the third bell rings.
8. All students should wear appropriate dress for school. (See McCracken County Code of Conduct) Because of safety concerns and educational distractions, baggy, loose fitting pants are unacceptable at RES. Appropriate footwear is required to be worn by our students. Due to the number of accidents caused by “flip-flop” type shoes, we request that students not wear these to school.

9. No trading at school unless it is an activity supervised by a teacher.
10. Book bags (**without wheels**) are permitted if the “Right to Search” Agreement has been properly signed and submitted.
11. All items, including book bags, brought to school by student must fit in the student’s (cubby) space (5"x40").
