

Parental involvement and community support are valued by the McCracken County Public Schools, and visitors are welcome. Since safety is a primary concern, all outside doors to the building remain locked at all times. Any visitor (including parents, media, community, etc.) must sign in at the office so that there is a record of everyone who is physically present in the building. Visitors will then be issued a “Visitor Badge” to be worn during their visit and returned upon leaving.

Although schools are public institutions, we have the right to limit access within the building for the safety of students and staff so as not to disrupt the instructional environment. Visitors should be aware that they cannot interrupt classes, school programs, or school business. Classroom visitors will be escorted to and from their destination. Teachers are instructed not to admit unauthorized visitors to the classroom.

Due to the flow of student traffic, cafeteria visitors will exit the cafeteria through the doors leading to the parking lot.
