Based on the most current data, Reidland Elementary School has 591 students, PreK through 3rd grade. We are located in Paducah, KY and are part of the McCracken County Public School system. We are about 71% free and reduced lunch status with 20% minority (8% Hispanic, 5% Black or African American, 6% two or more races).

We are very proud that our students at RES have an extra Music teacher, where students not only learn the fundamentals of music but also are exposed to music instruments like the violin, drums, recorder, to name a few. We also offer French as a Foreign Language to all Kindergarten through 3rd grade students.
