

Homework Due:

Go Fish Ten

1. You will need playing cards. You will need the cards aces (think of these as the ones) 2's, 3's, 4's, 5's, 6's, 7's, 8's, and 9's.
2. Shuffle the deck. Deal each player 7 cards and the rest is put in a stack face down between you and your partner(s).
3. Check to see if you have two cards that make 10 when added together. Put these pairs down in front of you.
4. Now look at the cards you have left and ask your partner for a specific number that you need to make a match that will equal 10. If your partner has it, he/she will give it to you and you can put the two cards in front of you. If not, your partner will say "Go Fish" and you will take a card from the stack in the middle.
5. Now it is your partner's turn to ask you for a card. The winner is the person who gets rid of all of his/her cards.
